

Hazardous Material/Emergency Response Agreement

From: Penobscot Bay Medical Center, Rockport, Maine

To: XYZ Company

The Penobscot Bay Medical Center (PBMC), Rockport, Maine agrees to provide medical assistance resulting from hazardous material emergencies, fires, or other disasters at the XYZ Company, Rockland, Maine.

This Hazardous Material/Emergency/Response Agreement is authorized and executed in accordance with the provision of 37-B MRSA ss 784 and 795, and is intended to conform fully with the requirements of those laws.

The scope of this agreement is intended to cover all equipment and personnel assistance provided by the PBMC in connection with any response to hazardous material emergencies, including, but not limited to, planning, joint drill or training exercises, incident response, or post-response activities.

XYZ acknowledges that the PBMC is immune from civil liability when providing assistance pursuant to this agreement.

After receipt of XYZ's request for assistance, the PBMC will inform XYZ immediately whether requested assistance can be provided, and under what conditions.

PBMC and XYZ agree that the PBMC will be guided by the Integrated Contingency Plan developed by XYZ.

XYZ shall be responsible for all costs associated with the PBMC response to a hazardous material incident at its facility, in response to a request for assistance from XYZ.
