LAW ENFORCEMENT CORRECTIONS OFFICER REGISTER

Sheriff Tim Carroll is continuously accepting applications for the position of Corrections Officer, both full-time and per-diem, through the use of a Register. The salary range for Patrol Deputy is \$17.43 - \$24.41 an hour, dependent upon similar previous work experience. Other benefits include family health insurance and MePERS retirement of 25 years, 2/3 pay and no age.

If you are interested in becoming a Corrections Officer, you must have a high school diploma or equivalent, have no disqualifying criminal conduct, be in good mental & physical health.

If you are interested and feel you meet these criteria; a Knox County Employment Application, along with proof of the below bullets, should be submitted to the County of Knox, Attention Sheriff Carroll, 62 Union St., Rockland, ME 04841.

- Satisfactory completion of the State of Maine Alert Test

Applicants who submit the required items will be placed on the Corrections Officer Register and remain for one year from the date of application.

As vacancies occur, the Sheriff will review the Register and select the most qualified applicants. Selected applicants will receive an invitation to participate in an oral interview. Upon successful completion of the interview, applicants will receive a conditional offer of employment; which includes undergoing a thorough background investigation and mental and physical examinations.

Faxed or emailed applications may not be accepted. Resumes alone may not be accepted but it is encouraged to send a resume with your application. Any other relevant information should be submitted with your application.
