Patrol Deputy REGISTER for Future Openings

The Knox County Sheriff's Office is currently accepting applications for the Patrol Deputy Register. This Register will be used when future openings occur.

Applicants interested in being placed on the Register must be high school graduates or equivalent, have no criminal record and be in good health. If these criteria are met, applicants should complete an application for employment and submit proof of the following:

- Satisfactory completion of the ALERT test
- Satisfactory completion of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy (MCJA) Pre-Service Training Course.
- Satisfactory completion of the MCJA Physical Agility Test within the past 6 months; if an applicant is not able to provide proof of the MCJA Physical Agility Test within the past 6 months, but meets all other requirements, the Sheriff's Department will schedule the Test.

Once an applicant meets all of the requirements above, s/he will be placed on the Register and remain on the Register one year from the date of application/full qualification.

When an opening for Patrol Deputy occurs, the Sheriff's Office will review the Register and select the most qualified candidate. This individual will be offered a temporary, full time position as Patrol Deputy for up to 90 days. Eligibility for benefits will be according to County policies. During this initial period, the employee will be closely supervised and the Sheriff's Office will determine the employee's overall suitability for the position. At any time during the 90 days, employment may be discontinued, or the employee may be selected for consideration for a regular, full time position. When the latter occurs, the employee will be scheduled for some or all of the following, depending on the circumstances:

- In-depth background check
- Written Exam(s)
- Oral Board
- Polygraph Examination
- Psychological Evaluation
- Physical Examination

Once the employee passes all required eligibility criteria, the employee will be offered the regular, full time position as Patrol Deputy.

The salary range for the Patrol Deputy position is \$17.56 - \$23.63/hr, depending on prior experience.

Application forms and job descriptions are available at the County Administrator's office, located on the ground floor of the Knox County Courthouse, 62 Union St. in Rockland, and are also available on the County's website: www.knoxcountymaine.gov. Any relevant certifications or training certificates should be submitted with your application.
